Senator Wright asked the following question at the hearing on 16 October 2012:

Funding of Community Programs under the Confiscated Assets Account:

- 1) In the 2012-13 Budget it was announced that nearly \$60 million of payments from the Confiscated Assets Account will be deferred over the coming four years. The last POCA Funding Round closed on 16 March 2012. Will any NGO, Local Government or Government sector funding rounds be announced during the 2012-13 financial year?
- 2) If no future funding rounds are planned for the 2012-13 financial year, is the Department continuing to accept any applications for NGO-sector funding?
- 3) What other Federal funding options are available for NGO and Local Government programs that provide important local crime prevention, drug treatment and drug diversionary measures?
- 4) In answers to questions during Budget Estimates 2012-2013, the Department indicated that an agreement was being negotiated with Neighbourhood Watch for a three-year funding package. What guidelines or procedures are in place to govern the negotiation of this type of one-to-one funding agreement outside of normal funding rounds?
- 5) Is the Department currently negotiating ongoing funding arrangements with any other non-government sector organisations, and if so, which ones?
- 6) What is the total amount of current funds in the Confiscated Assets Account? How much of this figure remains available to be spent on crime prevention, law enforcement and drug measures?
- 7) Since the Confiscated Assets Account was first established in 2003, how much funding has been allocated to community programs delivered by either NGOs or Local Governments as compared to Federal Government sector programs?
- 8) In answers to questions during Budget Estimates 2012-2013, the Department indicated there are approximately 200 active community based projects which will continue to run for a period of approximately 18 months to 2 years. Please provide a list of those projects which

will, or have already, come to an end during the financial 2012-13 year plus a separate list of those which will come to an end in the 2013-14 financial year?

9) Does the Department require and assist recipients of POCA Grants to submit outcomesfocussed evaluations of the projects for which they have received funding? If so, are these evaluations publicly available?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

- 1) As at 31 October 2012, no funding rounds were available to NGOs, Local Government or the Government sector. Any decision about conducting funding rounds in 2012-13 is a matter for Government.
- 2) No applications are only accepted whilst funding rounds are open.
- 3) Details of other potential sources of grant funding can be found at:

- 4) Decisions to award funding under POCA are made at the discretion of the Minister for Home Affairs and Justice, within the context of responsibilities under the Commonwealth Grants Guidelines and program parameters.
- 5) No.
- 6) As at 31 October 2012 the current balance of funds held in the CAA was just over \$65 million.
- 7) As at 31 October 2012 the Australian Government has awarded POCA funding of nearly \$97 million to 305 projects. This includes nearly \$46 million to 258 community projects (drug treatment/diversion measures as well as general crime prevention projects), and over \$51 million to 47 Australian Government projects (primarily law enforcement/crime prevention measures).
- 8) The information requested is set out in **Attachment A** and is accurate up to 31 October 2012.
- 9) The requirement for a grant recipient to submit an evaluation of their funded project is determined considering both the amount of funding received and the nature of the activity undertaken. Evaluations are not publicly available.

A total of 45 NGO projects funded under POCA have completed with a further 115 due for completion during the 2012-13 financial year.
