## SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES HEARING: 15 October 2012

IMMIGRATION AND CITIZENSHIP PORTFOLIO

Senator Humphries (written) asked:

Portfolio wide - Stationery requirements: How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) in 2011-12 and this financial year to date?

## Answer:

For the 2011-12 financial year the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) expended \$9,986.33 on stationery for the Hon Chris Bowen, MP, Minister for Immigration and Citizenship. For the 2012-13 financial year to date, the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) has expended \$972.46 on stationary for the Minister.

For the 2011-12 financial year DIAC expended \$1933.96 for stationery for Senator the Hon Kate Lundy, Minister for Multicultural Affairs, the Minister for Sport and the Minister assisting for Industry and Innovation. The provision of stationery requirements is currently managed by the Department of Industry, Innovation, Science, Research and Tertiary Education. The costs for the current financial year are yet to be attributed.
