The 2012–13 Humanitarian Program has been increased to 20 000 places, comprising 12 000 places for Refugee category visas with the balance to be shared between the Special Humanitarian Program category and Humanitarian visas granted onshore.

The Humanitarian Program does not have planning levels by country of origin, gender or age.
