Senator Ludwig (Written) asked:

Has there been a reduction in business flights? What are the estimated savings for each year over the forward estimates?

Answer:

The department has recorded a reduction in the volume of domestic business flights for the financial year to date as compared to the same period in the 2012-13 financial year, as shown in the table below. There has been an increase in the volume of international business flights for the financial year to date as compared to the same period last financial year. This reflects increased travel to and from regional processing centres in Nauru and Papua New Guinea.
