a) Has there been a reduction in the use of external consultants and contractors?
b) Has this impacted on the Department/agency, and how?
c) What are the estimated savings for each year over the forward estimates?
Answer:
a) Yes.
b) Yes, the reduction in the use of external consultants and contractors has created financial savings and an increase in APS FTE in the ICT area as an alternative to individual contractors.
c) The estimated savings for each year over the forward estimates period as a result of the reduction in contractors and consultants since 2012-13 is approximately \$7m pa. (This is based on an average \$50,000 difference on the cost of an APS FTE to contractor). It is assumed these savings are durable over the forward estimates.
MRT-RRT:
There has been a reduced use of external consultants and contractors in the year to 31 October 2013 compared to 2012-13. The reduction has not significantly impacted on the MRT-RRT. The use of consultants and contractors will vary over the years depending on changing needs.
