Mr Bowles: I would have to take any other specifics on notice, but it is not our practice to separate people like that.

Senator HANSON-YOUNG: Are there any families on Christmas Island who are currently separated?

Mr Bowles: We would have to take that on notice. I could not be definitive.

Answer:

Yes, on 19 November 2013 some families in detention on Christmas Island had been separated.
