Senator Heffernan asked:

- 1. What was the cost of Ministers travel and expenses for the Community Cabinet meetings held this FYTD?
- 2. How many Ministerial Staff travelled with the Minister for the Cabinet meeting? What was the total cost of this travel?
- 3. How many Departmental officers travelled with the Minister for the Cabinet meeting? What was the total cost of this travel?
- 4. What was the total cost to the Department and the Ministers office?

Answer:

1. Community Cabinet travel costs for the minister and ministerial staff are met by the Department of Finance and Deregulation (DoFD), with the exception of car costs for the minister, which are met by the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF).

The cost of Minister Ludwig's travel and expenses for the Community Cabinet meetings on 2 December 2010 and 29 June 2011 is provided in the table below.

2. Two ministerial staff attended the Community Cabinet meeting on 2 December 2010. DoFD has advised no costs were incurred for this travel.

Two ministerial staff attended the Community Cabinet meeting on 29 June 2011. DoFD has advised the costs incurred for this travel were \$1903.81.

3. One departmental officer accompanied Minister Ludwig to the Community Cabinet meeting on 2 December 2010. The cost to the department for the departmental officer's attendance at the meeting was \$739.40.

One departmental officer accompanied Minister Ludwig to the Community Cabinet meeting on 29 June 2011. The cost to the department for the departmental officer's attendance at the meeting was \$2299.66—this figure excludes COMCAR costs as invoices have not yet been received.
