Senator IAN MACDONALD: I would like to hear from you in person, but we have very limited time. Thank you, Mr Dickson, for that. I just want to go through a couple of other things. As a regional department, are you able to get for me the tax statistics in relation to the zone tax? For example, I would like to know how many people are in the special zone A and zone B, that is, how many access it and what the cost to the revenue is. You would normally tell me to go to Treasury and ask the question, but because this is very much a regional program and very much a northern program I am wondering whether you might have access to those figures.

**Ms Beauchamp:** We do not have automatic access to those figures. We would have to take that on notice and refer them to the Australian Taxation Office.

#### **Answer:**

The Department of the Treasury has advised that it is not possible to separate the revenue cost of the zone tax offset from the overseas forces tax offsets, as all are claimed and reported under the one category on tax returns. Nor, for the same reason, is it possible to determine the number of taxpayers in, or the cost to revenue of the zone tax offset for, ordinary zones A and B areas and the special areas in zones A and B.

The response to Parliamentary Question on Notice 783, tabled on 9 February 2012, provided information on the estimated total cost to revenue of the offsets and the number of claims under the zone and overseas forces tax offset category.

Estimates of the cost of the zone and overseas forces tax offsets in 2010-11 and later years are also provided in the 2011 *Tax Expenditures Statement*. The combined revenue cost of these offsets is estimated at \$230m for 2010-11, \$235m for 2011-12 and \$240m for 2012-13.

Attachment A provides a list of locations within tax zones A and B and other special areas, where persons are potentially eligible for special tax zone offsets.
