I wish to correct evidence given yesterday during the Australian Public Service Commission's appearance before Senate Estimates.

When asked to confirm details of the search undertaken of Mr Lloyd's emails, I stated that a global search had been done on the subject, topic and substance of emails looking for any reference to the IPA.

I have since been advised that this search was incorrectly undertaken for the period 26 August 2017 to 25 February 2018, and not for the correct 18 month period from 26 August 2016 to 25 February 2018.

This was an administrative error.

I can now confirm a full search of Mr Lloyd's emails including subject, topic and content has been undertaken for the correct period. It has identified a further email referencing the IPA, dated 6 July 2017, from the Commission's General Counsel to Mr Lloyd, referencing an FOI request.
