Daily summary

Here is the summary of today's proceedings in the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee estimates hearing.

The committee met from 9.00am until 11.00pm.

The committee called the Department of Home Affairs in relation to cross-portfolio/corporate/ general matters and Outcome 1 (Programs 1.1 to 1.8), under the Home Affairs portfolio.

Topics discussed by the committee included:

- proposed legislation regarding Australian Federal Police powers to compel the provision of identification in airports;
- possible cases of legionella contracted by personnel on Australian Border Force vessels;
- visa applications received from athletes, officials and others attending the Commonwealth Games; and
- a reported fire in the Hillside Haus accommodation centre in Manus Island.
