Daily summary

Here is the summary of today's proceedings in the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee estimates hearing.

The committee met from 9.00am until 11.02pm.

The committee called the following agencies and departments:

Attorney-General's Portfolio

- Office of the Australian Information Commissioner (OAIC)

Home Affairs Portfolio

- Australian Federal Police
- Australian Institute of Criminology and Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission
- Australian Security Intelligence Organisation
- Department of Home Affairs (cross-portfolio/corporate/general matters and Outcomes 1 and 2)

Outcome 3 of the Department of Home Affairs was released from the hearing without questions.

Topics discussed by the committee included:

- developments in the OAIC's investigation into privacy concerns relating to Facebook;
- AFP raid on a public servant's office within the Department of Home Affairs, including questions regarding parliamentary privilege;
- potential foreign interference in the upcoming federal election; and
- departure of Médecins Sans Frontières staff from Nauru.
