

Senate Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade Legislation Committee Supplementary Budget Estimates 2018-19 Wednesday, 24 October 2018 Daily summary

Here is the summary of today's proceedings in the Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade Legislation Committee estimates hearing.

The committee met from 9.00am until 10.55pm.

The committee called the following departments and agencies of the Defence Portfolio, including Veterans' Affairs.

Topics discussed by the committee included:

Department of Defence

- funding for the redevelopment of the Blackrock Camp in Fiji;
- funding for the upgrade of the PNG Defence Force Lombrum Naval Base in Manus Province;
- naval operations in the South China Sea;
- Defence submission to the review of the Defence Trade Controls Act 2012;
- Government announcement to consider re-locating the Australian Embassy from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem;
- Australia's relationship with Saudi Arabia;
- Defence cooperation with Myanmar;
- charter letters and division of ministerial responsibilities following the change of Prime Minister;
- naval shipbuilding workforce;
- Future Submarine Program including Strategic Partnership Agreement negotiations, and progress on meeting program milestones;
- PFAS contamination at defence bases; and
- Auditor-General's report: Army's Protected Mobility Vehicle Light.

- Australian Critical Infrastructure Framework; and
- electronic security of Australia's electoral systems.

Defence Housing Australia
