#### SELECTION OF BILLS COMMITTEE

#### REPORT NO. 4 OF 2018

- 1. The committee met in private session on Tuesday, 27 March 2018 at 7.30 PM.
- 2. The committee recommends that—
  - (a) contingent upon introduction in the House of Representatives, the *provisions* of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Amendment (Indigenous Land Corporation) Bill 2018; and the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Land and Sea Future Fund Bill 2018 and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Land and Sea Future Fund (Consequential Amendments) Bill 2018 be *referred immediately* to the Finance and Public Administration Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 7 May 2018 (see appendix 1 for a statement of reasons for referral);

  - (d) the *provisions* of the Road Vehicle Standards Bill 2018, Road Vehicle Standards (Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Bill 2018, Road Vehicle Standards Charges (Imposition General) Bill 2018, Road Vehicle Standards Charges (Imposition Customs) Bill 2018, and Road Vehicle Standards Charges (Imposition Excise) Bill 201 be *referred immediately* to the Rural and Regional Affairs and Transport Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 7 May 2018 (see appendix 4 for a statement of reasons for referral); and
  - (e) the *provisions* of the Social Services Legislation Amendment (Encouraging Self-sufficiency for Newly Arrived Migrants) Bill 2018 be *referred immediately* to the Community Affairs Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 4 May 2018 (see appendix 5 for a statement of reasons for referral).
