AUSTRALIAN-INDONESIAN SECURITY AGREEMENT

I submit the following:-

That NO treaty or agreement be signed with Indonesia until they agree to the following:-

- To dismantle both TNI and KOPASSUS and reform as neutral forces serving 1. a democratically elected Government.
- 2. Give open doors and full access for human rights monitors, foreign journalists and United Nations to investigate atrocities to native West Papuans, whenever any such groups wish to enter.
- Allow all foreign countries to deal with West Papuan refugees as they see fit 3. and cease all interference with the decision making processes of those countries.
- Fully, freely and democratically discuss with West Papuan leaders any plans 4. affecting country's destiny and the welfare of its indigenous people.

Condoning murder has become the Australian Government's trademark, for example Cambodia, West Papua and East Timor.

The greatest threat to this nation's security is not from a canoe load of terrified refugees, but from the Indonesian Military.
