Submission No. 124

I ask you not to ratify this Treaty, and not to enact the provisions of the International Criminal Court into Australia's domestic law.

Our national sovereignty is under threat.

- The Courts decisions would override Australia's parliaments & courts - Australia would give power to the ICC.
- The ICC has "universal jurisdiction" to enforce laws that are not in our domestic law.
- The Court has power over "murder, extermination --- persecution, inhumane acts as well as genocide and war crimes" One judge has allegedly said she would like to indict the pope....
- Terms such as "genocide" can be interpreted by the Court as discrimination against homosexuals.
- Excessive penalties of 30 years or life imprisonment can be given by the ICC.

This is excessive, draconian & tyrannical.
This would totally change our current laws.

This is appalling.

Please, I beg you, do not support this Bill.
