WITH THE EXTRAORDINARY JUDGEMENT OF MR. JUSTICE NORTH
SHOULD CONVINCCE YOUR COMMITTEE TO IMMEDIATELY ABANDON
ANY CONSIDERATION OF THE ABOVE LEGISLATION.

THE CONSEQUENCES OF COMMITTING TO THIS TREATY SHOULD BE
OBVIOUS TO YOUR COMMITTEE IN LIGHT OF ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS
AND THE POTENTIAL INVASION RISK THEY POSE AS A CONSEQUENCE
OF MR NORTH'S WISDOM .

LIKE MANY OF THE OTHER 2000 TREATIES TO WHICH WE HAVE BEEN
COMMITTED THERE IS NO DOUBT THIS ONE WILL FURTHER WEAKEN
AUSTRALIA'S SOVREIGNTY AND IT WILL PLACE OUR PEOPLE AT THE
WHIM OF A JUSTICE SYSTEM THE CONSEQUENCES OF WHICH WE WILL
SUFFER AND OVER WHICH WE WILL HAVE NO CONTROL.

IT IS MY WILL THAT THE COMMITTEE STRONGLY RECOMMEND
AGAINST THIS PROPOSED LEGISLATION FORTHWITH.
