Tasmania made a formal submission to the Joint Standing Committee on the National Capital and External Territories addressing the *Inquiry into the Adequacy of Funding for Australia's Antarctic Program.* Following this submission, I appeared before a hearing of the Joint Standing Committee on the National Capital and External Territories that was held in Hobart.

The Tasmanian Government would like to make a supplementary submission to this Inquiry. Please find attached additional information for members of the Joint Standing Committee. This information relates to funds expended by the Tasmanian Government on scientific activities and management of Macquarie Island.

The attached table summarises the financial and in-kind contributions that the Tasmanian Government has made over a five-year period in supporting scientific programs and undertaking management activities on Macquarie Island.

The Tasmanian Government urges the members of the Joint Standing Committee to recommend that sufficient funding be provided to the Australian Antarctic Division to secure the continued provision of logistic support for Macquarie Island. This surety is required for the long-term continuation of monitoring programs and management activities undertaken on Macquarie Island.

I would be pleased to provide additional information to the Inquiry if it assists with the deliberations of the Joint Standing Committee.

Tasmanian Government Expenditure for Management and Scientific Programs on Macquarie Island

- The Tasmanian Government has previously allocated a total of \$2.67 million over a five-year period to Macquarie Island management and scientific programs. This equates to an annual allocation of \$534,000.
- The Feral Cat Eradication Program was successfully concluded in 2003.
- Management plans for Macquarie Island and introduced species will be completed in 2004.
- In forthcoming years, substantial programs will be introduced to address the eradication of rats and rabbits.
