

Our mother work us home on & off, but we would have been leetter off if ple just left us there as wel went weithout lunch at school and the nuns use to quie us feed from their consent at St. manys livery time we went back to the appearage we use to get belted. no one can ent from the Ekilotren Dervices to talk to the hids as we user all dressed up when wisitous came and get back in our your clothes again as pour as they left. I went to work in the nursely looking after the balues when I was faurteen. lively now and

then the nun in the nursery use to beelt us works with the hardle of a straw brown (The pat stick). Istile to the clay don't know why she go stuck into us. Then when I was picteen she got pluch into me with the pat stick I had all livingle over me for a well on my arms neck and less. I hick under the kitchen for I days and one of the girls in the Kitchen use to living me Levol. I careered impelfup at night weith the poet atre packs that well under the lawilding . I came put after a comple of days and necest seent back to the newself for 50days. The nun left for 6 michs as she had a lileah derren. noticoly asked me at lame to see me to tell them what happened my mather came to see me on the Saturday or my bruise's were facting them. I left neerhall when I trunce lighteen. I have lead night males at night. I have to take antidepressin tables wery day. Sending these papers out of my files to let you see I'm not telling hies. 
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

There has never been any question of the home surroundings, of Mrs. Woods, and in fact, on one occasion, when Mr. Harris was in this Office, he visited Mrs. Woods' home and was very satisfied with the manner in which it is kept.



The Department has been responsible for maintaining all of Mrs. Woods' children, and these are disposed of as follows:-

Neville - former St. Joseph's Home.

at present living at home and unemployed.

Noel - 18 years of age this month. He is a good type of lad and remained with his employer, with whom he has

been since leaving St. Joseph's Home. Colleen - At present employed at St. Joseph's Home.
Gloria - passed the last Scholarship Examination and boarded

at St. Patrick's College, Mackay. Kathleen, Darryl and - Boarded at St. Joseph's Home.

Kevin. Lorraine,

Mervyn, Beverley and - Living with Mrs. Woods and receiving assistance from this Department. Graham

As Mrs. Woods wishes to have her children home with her, it is recommended that Kathleen, Darryl and Kevin be transferred from board at St. Joseph's Home, Neerkoll to board with their mother at the end of the present school vacation, as it is probable that arrangements had already been completed for the children to spend the vacation in private homes. In this regard, my letter of the 5th instant shows that the house in which this family reside, is large and providing extra beds are bought, there will be ample accommodation for the additional three children.

When Mrs. Woods called at the Office yesterday, she alleged that Colleen, who is employed at St. Joseph's Home, Neerkoll, received a severe belting approximately two weeks ago, as a result of which she



and I asked her whether any bruises were visible at that time, but she lated that there was no sign of them.

It would be appreciated if you will advise whether the three children may be transferred to board with their mother as recommended, and also whether I should make further enquiries into the allegation that Colleen has been ill-treated.
