Palister girls home at Greenwich in the yrs of 61-64, in which the Deconesses, were verbally & physically abusive.

Parramatta girls home 1964-1965, was an absolute nightmare, where ~~we~~ we were subjected to inhumane, frightening, and complete demoralisation as young girls.

I have suffered all my life because of this, I am on a disability pension for severe depression & have a Borderline Personality disorder. I am agoraphobic. I have struggled through life the best I can.

I want nothing more than recognition for all these kids whose lives have been one of constant struggle as a result of the mistreatment these places has afflicted upon their young minds.

There are thousands of home kids & State wards that need to have this made public & recognition for the tragedy of their lives, so as they may have a chance to heal.
