I wish to make a submission to the *Inquiry into the effectiveness of the broadcasting codes of practice*.

I believe that Channel 9 (with Ramsey's Kitchen) is overstepping the bounds of decency. Profanities are used constantly for no other reason than to cause controversy. I was disgusted with a 60 minutes episode (20<sup>th</sup> April) when they replayed parts of a Ramsey show, complete with swearing, at 8.10 pm. There have also been several pieces about the show on A Currant Affair (with beeps) which I believe is purely for promotional reasons.

I have to admit to not watching this show after a few minutes of the first episode but I cannot get away from it if they continue to blatantly promote it on news and currant affairs programs.

I am not a prude but I do not wish to be bombarded with this type of language used in such an obviously offensive way.
