Re: Nuclear Waste Dump at Muckaty

Dear Trish and Warren,

The people who have signed this letter want you to know that we are very upset with you both, and Prime Minister Rudd and Minister Ferguson.

Trish, you said in September last year in a media release that "Labor is committed to repealing the Commonwealth Radioactive Waste Management Act if it wins government."

During the election in November last year we voted for you both because we thought your ALP mob would turn back the Commonwealth Radioactive Waste Management Act and look after our country.

Peter Garrett said in a media release about Muckaty ."..Labor understands that many families in the area are strongly opposed to the waste dump idea, and that these families are concerned their rights have been ignored in the process."
