

Dear Sir,

I wish to strongly urge the Committee to seek undertakings from the Federal & S.A. Governments that they will stop the use of I.S.L. mining in the S.A. uranium mines of Beverley, Honeymoon, and require rehabilitation of mining impacts on ground water.

I have for long been disgusted that the Federal Government has allowed the Ranger mines at Jabiluka and Koongarra in Kakadu, and the fact that over 110 environmental breaches have been reported at Ranger shows the damage that is being done.

Obviously mining should be stopped in heritage areas and monitoring programs, & the enforcement of regulations by Commonwealth agencies at all uranium mines must be improved.
