I'm writing to relate to your Senate Commitee my first-hand experience of having my job within the finance industy offshored. I'm currently employed by the NAB and will be until the 27th February of this year. On this date I will be ending a sixteen year relationship with my employer due to the fact that my current role can be performed by an overseas counterpart for less than a tenth of the salary that I currently earn.

My role and countless others performed by my collegues with professionalism & dedication to customer service will be terminated because of the greed of what was once a great organisation to work for. This is not a move made to increase customer service levels but a short-sighted attempt to cut costs at the expense of hard-working and decent people.

The fact is that our jobs are being moved to a country were Industry working standards & Wage levels are significantly less than what they are in Australia. It appears to simply be a "race to the bottom" to exploit the workforces of third world countries.

I urge you as members of the Senate Committe to make the decisions that will help keep jobs in this country not only for my generation but also our childrens.
