- My Family and I do not receive any benefits from the Government what so ever, we are not registered with Centre Link or any other type of Government centers, we have never received any child payment, family allowances, and first home buyer package.
- When working overseas in places like Mauritania in Africa we do not have the comforts or the security of what we have in Australia, like food, medical aid. Also we pay taxes in these Countries and never receive any type of receipt from their Government, so therefore we would be paying taxes twice.
- I am only in the country for 4-1/2 to 5 months of the year and all my income is spent in Australia,
- If we are to pay tax there should be some consideration regarding time spent in Australia and our conditions as we do not have the same privileges as our fellow works in Australia.
 1. We work 12 hour day's minimum for 28 days straight.
 2. We do not receive any sick pay, holiday pay, annual leave pay, redundancy packages, superannuation, all we get is a salary and that's it.
 3. There are no unfair dismissal laws or unions to protect you.
