On the 10th of April 2008,i signed a legal contract for the purchase of two company vehicles,which i am currently waitlisted.(see attached documents).I did not and could not, foresee the increase in luxury car sales tax,in regard to this i find it unfair and unjust that i should now be subject to such an increase as i signed a legal document with the car dealership prior to the date in which the new tax law comes into effect.This increase, amounts to a total of \$4300,quite a substantial amount which we could not have budgeted for.Due to the nature of our contract being legally binding we are in the unfortunate position of not being able to look for another alternative to reduce the cost to our company and purchase before 1st of July.I believe the company should be exempt from this extra amount as i signed my contract in good faith with no prior knowledge of any increase in luxury car sales tax.
