#### Dear Senator Hogg

Thank you for your letter of 29 June 2000 to the Chief Minister, Mrs Kate Carnell MLA, seeking submissions on the Defence Legislation Amendment (Aid to Civilian Authorities) Bill 2000 which is currently under consideration by your Committee. As the Chief Minister is currently overseas, I am responding on her behalf.

The Defence Legislation Amendment (Aid to Civilian Authorities) Bill 2000 provides a legal framework for the ACT to apply to the Commonwealth for the call out of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) in law enforcement emergencies. The ACT Government supports the intention of this Bill. The ACT notes that the ADF call out procedures are currently provided for in the National Anti-Terrorist Plan (NATP). In light of the proposed amendments put forward in the Bill, the Plan would need to be revised.
