As you know, the Senate Select Committee on Regional and Remote Indigenous Communities conducted public hearings in Fitzroy Crossing, Halls Creek and Broome from 24 - 26 August 2009 as part of the committee's ongoing inquiry process.

During these hearings the committee undertook to seek information in response to queries or issued raised with us. The committee is writing to you seeking further information relating to issues that are likely to fall within the responsibility of the government of Western Australia. These issues are detailed in the attachment to this letter.
