- 2. ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR. ISBF outcome: operating business (ABN 66 903 455 411 T/A Geff Winters Electrical) -Mobile contractor business. Objective: to employ Indigenous Apprentices. Moved business operation to ACT 2007.
- 3. AGRICULTURAL SERVICES. ISBF Outcome: Translated to operating business (ABN 96 503 708 811) throughout rural NSW; moving ahead with development of aerial mustering component of business currently seeking capital funding for aircraft purchase. Base: Bourke NSW; objective: expand enterprise and train Indigenous stockmen.
- 4. GOODOOGA STORE / FUEL OUTLET. ISBF Outcome: Business plan produced instrumental in community's approach to several agencies/ funding streams objective: purchase currently operating business at Goodooga and expand to include fuel outlet. Negotiations continuing. IBA to evaluate proposal TBA.
- 5. REGIONAL DRIVER TRAINING SCHOOL Operated under MPREC (ABN 52 100 602 518). Instructors completed training and dleivering training services in region.
- 6. BUS SERVICE. Based at Bourke. Translated to operating business (ABN) Sole Trader: Objective: to expand run and take on Indigenous drivers.
- 7. COMMERCIAL NURSERY. ISBF Outcome: Business Plan demonstrated viability / sustainability of project. Corporate / Community Partnership Peak Gold Mines. Proposers have translated project to start-up business (ABN 14 935 763 917 Cobar & Western Region Enterprise Devleopent Inc). Project stalled by inability to access start-up capital (\$300,000)TBA Work In Progress.
- 8. STEEL SUPPLY AND MANUFACTURING (Based Coonamble) ISBF Outcome: Business Plan isntrumental to translation to operating business Coonamble Steel and Produce ABN 17 130 628 536.
