I would like to submit a short  
submission to the Select Committee on the  
Administration of Indigenous Affairs.

I am gravely concerned that the  
Government is systematically reducing  
the independent voice of Aboriginal  
people. Indigenous people must have  
genuine involvement in decision-making  
which affects their lives and their  
communities.

There needs to be a National Indigenous Representative body which reflects the views, values and aspirations of aboriginal people and which is open & accountable to local people. The abolition of ATSIC without a blueprint of a new body is incorrect protocol and deeply offensive to the many many Aboriginal people committed to making their communities supportive and strengthening of culture & family.

The replacement of ATSIC is a priority and must be implemented through informed consent of aboriginal people.

The new structure must be resourced to function well and enabled to respond to local & regional community needs & issues.
