Emotional and Social Well Being Regional Centres

11 of these centres were established under the Mental Health Action Plan from 1996, with \$20.5 million being provided over a 4 year period. They were located at:

• Western Australia: Broome, Perth

Northern Territory: Darwin, Alice Springs

South Australia: Adelaide;

• Victoria: Melbourne;

New South Wales: Sydney, Armidale

• Tasmania: Hobart;

• Queensland: Brisbane, Cairns²

Approximately \$1m was to be spent in 1999/2000 to expand existing some centres³

4 new centres were established under *Bringing Them Home* (\$17M): the priority areas identified were at:

- Queensland central and western;
- New South Wales: southern and western (including ACT);
- Western Australia: Goldfields area;⁴

These areas have received 'seed funding to undertake developmental work'.5
