Statement of Union of Australian Women on proposed changes to the Human Rights and Equal Opportunity Commission.

The Union of Australian Women opposes the proposed amendments to the Human Rights and Equal Opportunity Commission as outlined by the Federal Government in its Australian Human Rights Commission Legislation Bill 2003.

We strongly object to the renaming of the Commission and believe the words Equal Opportunity must not be eliminated.

We oppose any restriction of the principles upon which the Commission was established and any restriction of its current functions.

The Commission must remain an independent body which has the freedom to carry out its functions of monitoring and promoting Australia's compliance with our human rights obligations under international agreements. It must also retain the ability to intervene in a court case raising a human rights principle.
