**Inquiry into the Exposure draft of Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-terrorism Financing Bill 2005**

I refer to your letter dated 16 February 2006 seeking ASIO's comments in relation to an exposure draft of the proposed Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-terrorism Financing Bill 2005. I note the draft Bill is intended to implement in Australia the revised Forty Recommendations of the Financial Action Task Force on Money Laundering and the Nine Special Recommendations on Counter-Terrorism Financing.

ASIO supports the principle of this Bill and considers it very important that Australia's anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing system is strengthened. The proposed Bill should further support ASIO security investigations with the enhanced obligations relating to those entities providing designated services and increased provisions of the Bill in line with Financial Action Task Force Recommendations.

ASIO is still considering the exposure draft and has identified some issues for internal deliberation. These issues will be progressed separately with the Attorney-General's Department as part of that Department's consultation process.
