DEMOCRATS ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

- 1.1 The Democrats understand and support the intent of the legislation but reserve our right to amend the bill.
- 1.2 We agree with the evidence as presented in the Chair's report.
- 1.3 The Democrats have longstanding concerns regarding the protection of sensitive health information, specifically DNA information.
- 1.4 We are particularly concerned that DNA information on a State or Territory database that is erased, may not be similarly erased from the NCIDD records as indicated in the Chair's Report (Recommendation 1, page 9, 2.49, lines 4-5). This is a potential privacy issue. It is unclear in the way the Report's recommendation is currently drafted if residual DNA information from a State or Territory database will lie on the NCIDD indefinitely, and if so, why this should be the case.
