The NSW Fire Brigades further hopes that the Federal Privacy Commissioner will work with State and Territory Privacy Commissioners, the Australian Law Reform Commission's Inquiry into the Privacy Act, and the NSW Law Reform Commission's inquiry into NSW privacy legislation to promote the incorporation of corresponding provisions in privacy legislation in their jurisdictions, with the aim of having a uniform approach to such situations, as emergencies and disasters often impact on more than one jurisdiction.
