INQUIRY INTO THE PRIVACY LEGISLATION AMENDMENT (EMERGENCIES AND DISASTERS) BIII 2006

Thank you for the invitation to the AFP to make a submission to the Parliamentary inquiry into the *Privacy Legislation Amendment (Emergencies and Disasters) Bill 2006.*

The AFP believes the sharing of information between organisations to locate, identify or assist people affected by a disaster or emergency is fundamental to the effective management of a response to these situations. The sharing of this information will also improve the ability of these organisations to inform families and others about those affected by a disaster or other emergency situation.

Accordingly, the AFP supports the amendments to the *Privacy Act 1988* to allow the lawful sharing of information between agencies, state and territory authorities, private sector organisations and non-government organisations, in a declared emergency or disaster situation.
