Re: Questions on Notice for Senate Standing Committee on Legal and Constitutional Affairs: Inquiry on the Rights of the Terminally III bill 2008

I write to forward AMSANT's answers to Questions on Notice put to Mr Des McKenzie, who gave evidence on behalf of AMSANT at the Senate Legal & Constitutional Affairs Committee's hearing on 15 April in relation to the Rights of the Terminally III Bill 2008.

Question 1: At the time the Northern Territory legislation came into effect in 1995, was AMSANT in existence and did it make any submission or representation to the Northern Territory government about the legislation?

Answer: Yes, AMSANT was in existence at the time but did not make a submission or representation to the NT government about the issue.

Question 2: Does AMSANT have a view as to whether the Northern Territory government's right to consider euthanasia should be reinstated, or whether there should be consultation about this first?

Answer: AMSANT agrees that the NT government's right to consider the issue of voluntary euthanasia should be reinstated and that this is a separate issue which should not require prior consultation with the community.

I hope this information is of assistance to the Committee.
