# SENATE INQUIRY INTO MENTAL HEALTH

# PUBLIC HEARING IN MELBOURNE

The Senate Select Committee on Mental Health will hold **public hearings** in Melbourne on **Tuesday to Thursday 5-7 July 2005**.
