Importation of beef from nations where BSW has occurred is a quarantine matter **NOT** a trade matter.

It must **NOT** occur.

Australian primary producers are not supported by governments.

They receive very low prices for their commodities.

Beef producers must comply with government regulations, such as the NLIS lifetime traceability programme, to secure export markets.

The EU demands a host of special imposts so that Australian Beef Producers can supply to that market, and we do despite their purile nit picking nature but the Government will permit imports from nations which don't have the same protocols.

Where is justice for us?
