

In response to the above, under reference, document regarding the subject issue, we communicate the following:

According to article 27 of the Greek Nationality Code (L.3284/2004) combined with article 1 of the Provisions Code for Male Registries (L.2119/1993), the acquisition of greek nationality/citizenship is proven by the registration within the Municipal and Male Registries (cases of males) of the Greek State.

In the specific case, and after investigation conducted by our Offices in the Database of the National Registry, no such registration of McCORMACK Michael Francis (son) of Lance Trevalion (or Trevalism) Thomas and Eileen Margaret, born in 1964 in Australia, in either the Municipal or Male Registries appeared.

Furthermore, in regards to the grandfather of Mr. McCORMACK Michael Francis, namely George Peter MARGOSIS, allegedly born in 1896 in either Corinth or Akrata, following search conducted by our Offices, no registration of his in the Municipal and/or Male Registries of either the Municipality of Corinth or the Municipality of Aigialeia appeared.

Consequently, the acquisition of Greek citizenship by Messrs George Peter MARGOSIS and Michael Francis McCORMACK is not proven and, as per the provisions of the aforementioned legislation, they are not considered Greek citizens.
